## ASCENSION THURSDAY

This moveable feast is observed 40 days after Easter. It is a Holy Day of Obligation which commemorates the Ascension of Christ into heaven 40 days after His Resurrection from the dead. The Ascension recalls the completion of Christ's mission on earth for the salvation of all people and His entry into heaven with a glorified human nature. The Ascension is a pledge of the final glorification of all who achieve salvation. Documentary evidence of the feast dates from early in the 5<sup>th</sup> century, but it was observed long before that time in connection with Pentecost and Easter.

**Masses for the Holy Day of Obligation will be held on Wednesday, May 25 at 6:00 pm and on Thursday at 9:00 am in the church.**

You may enroll your father in a special novena of nine Masses for all our fathers to begin on Father's Day, June 19<sup>th</sup>. The forms are available in the bulletin and at the church entrances, and they include the dates that the Masses will be celebrated. Please fill out the form, clearly writing your father's name or the name of the man, or men, you wish to have Masses offered for, your name and mark "living" or "deceased." Please place the form in an envelope with your offering marked "Father's Day Novena," or use the special envelope you receive in your envelope packet, or those at the church entrances, and drop it in the collection basket or at the Parish Office. If your father is living, you can stop in at the Sacristy after Mass or at the office and pick up a beautiful Spiritual Bouquet card to present to your father for Father's Day. **All requests MUST BE IN BY TUESDAY, JUNE 14.** Thank you.

## DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS

St. Patrick's will join several parishes in our Diocese in a novena of prayer for church vocations on **Tuesday, May 31** in our chapel from 10:00am - 4:00pm. During each hour a rosary will be offered for vocations. The novena will end with a special holy hour with Bishop Lucia at the Cathedral on June 4 at 10:00 am. ## EASTER DUTY

Among the precepts of the Church are the duties to receive Holy Communion at least once a year, during the Easter season (can. 920) and to confess grave sins at least once a year (can. 989). These precepts often go together because in order to receive Holy Communion, one must be in a "state of grace," that is free from grave sin (can. 916). Thus, they are called the "Easter duties." In the United States, the Easter duties may be fulfilled at any time between the First Sunday of Lent (March 6, 2022) and Trinity Sunday (June 12, 2022). When it is impossible for those who have not already done so to fulfill these duties, they are suspended.

## Relics of St. Bernadette to Tour the US including Syracuse, NY

The Sanctuary of Lourdes in partnership with Lourdes North American Volunteers, The Sovereign Order of Malta and The Hospitality of Miami are thrilled to announce that for the first time in US history, **the relics of St. Bernadette will be in Syracuse, NY from Saturday, May 28<sup>th</sup>-Tuesday, May 31<sup>st</sup>**. The relics will travel between Holy Family Church, The Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception and Sacred Heart in Cicero. The Vatican has granted a plenary indulgence for those visiting the relics during the tour and meeting the usual conditions. It is an extraordinary opportunity to discover Lourdes, pray with St. Bernadette, follow her example of holiness and to allow God to increase our own faith. The relics will be at Holy Family Church, Fairmount on **Saturday, May 28**: Mass at 5:00 – 6:30pm. with a Welcome Ceremony and Veneration of Relics and Holy Hour. In addition, also at Holy Family, on **Tuesday, May 31**: Mass at 5:00pm, Veneration of relics at 6:00pm and at 7:00pm the Lourdes Virtual Pilgrimage Experience and Anointing of the Sick.
