125th CELEBRATION NEWS

The committees have been working hard preparing for our 125th Anniversary Celebration on **Sunday, July 17th**. Bishop Lucia will be here to celebrate our Mass at 10:00am. RESPECT LIFE MINISTRY

For 9 weeks, which began on Mothers’ Day, our whole parish is **spiritually adopting pre-born children**, using the prayer on the back of the bulletin. We will have a Baby Shower during the eighth and ninth weeks and donations will be given to Pregnancy Help Centers in the area. Of course, you can continue to pray for your adopted baby for the full nine months of his or her time in the womb!

CONCEPTION: When the father’s sperm and mother’s egg unite, a new human being, with a unique set of DNA, comes into existence. Many beautiful details are already present – sex, eye color, hair color, body type, and more!

DEVELOPMENT OF YOUR ADOPTED BABY – MONTH 6:

MONTH 6: I’m sitting up now!

Your baby sits erect to accommodate a slight internal organ shift and the oil and sweat glands are functioning, which helps regulate body temperature. A white, filmy layer, called the vernix, covers the baby to protect his/her delicate skin from the amniotic fluid. This will be absorbed quickly shortly after birth. The lungs are fairly well developed and the baby can respond to outside sounds, like the voice of his mother. If born at this time, the baby has a good chance of survival.
